Admission Policy

The admission rules are notified as per Government gazette, Department of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy development and Fisheries dated 01/06/2018. As per the eligibility, conditions and criteria's mentioned in this Gazette, the CET organized by competent authority is mandatory for admissions. The admission procedure in these courses will be conducted under control of Admission Regulatory Authority, Government of Maharashtra.

As per the Government Resolution, Department of Agriculture and Animal Husbandry, Dairy Science and Fisheries MCAER No.2010/ letter No. 155 / 7-A, dated, 20/10/2011 the Government of Maharashtra has finalized the strategy of reservation of seats, procedure for the distribution of social reservations and the admission procedure for the degree course of four year duration.

Basic eligibility for admission is

- 1. The age of the candidate should be 16 years as on last date of submission of Centralized Admission Process.
- 2. Candidates must have passed the qualifying examination (12th Std. Science) with minimum 50% marks for General category (Open) and minimum 40% marks in aggregate for reserved categories.
- 3. Candidate must qualify XII Std. (Science) passed in 10+2 pattern from Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent Examination, with PCM or PCB, PCMB and English & Common Entrance Examination i.e. MHT-CET/JEE/NEET organized by Competent Authority.
- 4. Every year Prospectus is uploaded on website by the CET Cell, Mumbai. Banner, Leaflet & Admission Brochure is prepared for wide advertisement of Admission. Notices related to admission & other information is also displayed on Notice board & college website.
- 5. Intake capacity of Admission is sanctioned by Mahatma Phule Krishi Vidyapeeth, Rahuri & Maharashtra Council of Agriculture Education and Research, Pune.

- 6. Annual Fees may change as per the decisions of Fee Regulating Authority, Mumbai from time to time.
- 7. Twenty Percent seats of intake capacity is allotted for Institutional Quota. Out of remaining 80% seats of intake capacity, 30% for Maharashtra Quota ('M' Quota) and 70% for Agriculture University Quota ('U') Quota.
- 8. Every applicant should fill only one application form 'online' on website https://ug.agriadmissions.in & upload all necessary document of Admission.
- 9. Provisional Merit List, Final Merit List & CAP rounds are declared by competent authority every year as per schedule of Admission process notified in Prospectus.
- 10. Selection of Candidates is done on the basis of merit of total percentile marks obtained in the respective group (PCB/PCM/PCMB) in MHT-CET /JEE/NEET Examination and the other applicable weightages.
- 11. Depending on Merit, Reservation & Preference given by candidate allotment for various CAP rounds as per schedule is done.
- 12. After completion of Admission process, time-to-time instructions given by Admission Regulatory Authority for approval of admitted candidates followed critically.
- 13. As per rule of State Government & Central Government, Scholarship is given to eligible reserved category candidates.
- 14. Rules & Regulations of Admission Process may change as per notification of the State CET Cell, Mumbai. Candidates are requested to visit website www.ug.agriadmissions.in for updates.
- 15. Commencement of Classes are as per schedule declared by the State CET Cell, Mumbai & MCAER, Pune.
